President Janet Zabukovic's Message

Dear Fellow Serrans,



Autumn is sneaking in with its warm days and cool nights and a kaleidoscope of colors donning the vegetation. This is my favorite time of the year, because to me it feels like nature is taking a deep breath after the hard work of growing in the summer. I find that in the autumn, I tend to be more reflective. In my daily meditations for several days now, the theme has been God's plan for each of our lives and the need to trust in that plan. I've been thinking a lot about that over the past week or two. It is easy to say we trust in God's plan, but it can be harder to live out that reality. There have been many times in my life when I have struggled to understand and accept that what is happening is part of God's plan. When each of my twin girls died nine and a half years apart, I really struggled to not be angry at God and to try to see how their deaths could possibly be part of a kind and loving God's

plan. When I became a single Mom, it was hard for me to see why that was part of the plan.

I have shared in the past that after my son left home to attend Notre Dame, I became an occasional Catholic and was not faithfully attending Mass or living out my faith. I have shared with some of you how God gently and persistently called me back home to my faith despite my stubbornness in responding to that call. My life after I returned to the faithful practice of Catholicism is so much richer, and part of that richness is my involvement in my parish and in Serra. Most of you know how I nearly died from sepsis in early December 2023 and how two of my close friends and fellow Serrans, Laura Jean Hawley and Pat Van Matre, literally saved my life. I truly believe that through God's grace and their guardian angels, they became God's way of saving my life. So how does all that play into the theme of God's plan for our lives?

Last Saturday at the vigil Mass, Fr. Jason talked about trusting God and his plan even when we don't understand it. As I was driving home from Mass, I had this sudden flash of insight about exactly that. It dawned on me that if God had not been persistent in calling me home, if he had not given me the grace to finally listen and respond, I would never have met either Laura Jean or Pat, both my fellow Divine Redeemer parishioners. And had I never met them and become

friends with them, they never would have been in the position to know that something had to be very wrong with me when I quit responding to their texts, phone calls and emails on that December Sunday evening. Without them knowing and responding, I likely would have died unconscious on that hard bathroom floor. I got a sudden glimpse of God's plan in action- one whose individual pieces gave not a hint of how they would all interact in such an impactful way! I still do not understand why some of those very hard things happened in my life, but I know that I can trust in God and his plan!

Our seminarians have returned to the seminaries. Let's remember to pray for them, for all discerners, and for those who have already answered God's call to serve as Priests and other religious.


