**Serra Volunteers needed to distribute Brochures!**

Updated Serra Brochures will soon be ready. ## Treasurer's Report – Jan 2025

Dear Serra Members,

I am trying the use of email in an effort to save about \$40 in postage stamps as well as paper and envelopes. The annual dues for our Colorado Springs Serra Apostolate are due. The annual amount is \$120 per person, or \$180 per couple (50% discount for spouses). Paying the annual amount is the most expedient way of handling the payment. However, you may also pay half (\$60 per person, \$90 per couple) now, and the same amount again in July.

Finally, if absolutely necessary, you may pay \$10 per month (\$15 per couple) each month, although this creates significantly extra work for both you and the treasurer.
