Dear Fellow Serrans,

It's hard to believe that we are now already a month into the new year! January went out with freezing temperatures and snow! Just going out to get the paper required a warm coat, a hat, and gloves! I have been thinking about how blessed I am to have warm clothes and a warm and safe home, and thinking about all those people and animals who were not as fortunate. Many do not have warm clothes, a warm and safe home, clean water, healthy food, and love. Sometimes, it is easy to forget about those who are living a marginalized life and struggling to make ends meet to provide for themselves and their families. I think about the discussions we had during my Biblical School classes about our call to love and care for the poor and needy, and to be good caretakers of our earthly home and the creatures that inhabit it with us. February is a month that focuses on love since Valentine's Day will be here soon. It is easy to show love to those we already know and

love. It is harder to show love to those we do not know or do not particularly like or feel connected to. But Jesus called us all to first love him and then to love our neighbor. Does our love extend to those we don't know, those in need, those who don't look like us, those who have different opinions than we do? Do we take seriously our responsibility to care for all of God's creation with compassion and mercy? Perhaps February, with its focus on love, is a great time to think about how we love and how our actions reflect our call to love.

Our St. Serra Apostolate has once again entered a contest sponsored by Serra International/ Serra USA that is directed at increasing Serra membership around the world. We will be holding our Bishop's Membership Luncheon in just a few weeks. As a papal society, the president of Catholic Extension is appointed by the Pope himself. Father Jack Wall was appointed by the Holy See as president in 2007. Prior to leading Catholic Extension Society, Father Wall served 24 years as pastor of Old St. Patrick's Church in Chicago. Under his stewardship, the

struggling urban church grew from four to 4,000 households, making it one of the most vibrant faith communities in Chicago today.

The annual Serra USA Rally was held in Miami, Jan 23-26. As usual, there were some really good speakers. Among them were Archbishop Wenski of Miami, Cardinal Thomas Collins, Bishop Thomas Daly, the Rector of the local Seminary, the Diocesan Vocations Director who was just ordained in May of 2024, and Sister Adela, who was a speaker at the Eucharistic Congress that everyone raved about. We went to their convent and had Mass there, and they gave us each a small loaf of Mango or Guava bread.



They also had training sessions for all five ministries (including Cultural Outreach) for the entire assembly, rather than making them breakout sessions, where attendees could only go to two of them. Since there were only 88 attendees and they had contracted for 110 or 120, we had plenty of food and the wine and drinks were free!

Starting next year, we will be holding the Rally in a more reasonable venue, so perhaps more will be able to attend. The 2026 Rally will be held at the Augustine Inst in St. Louis, MO. Next on the agenda is the SI convention in Kansas City, June 26 - 29, 2025. It may be possible to drive to this one, for those who enjoy road trips.
